What is Community Planning?


Community Planning is a process where community members come together and take action to improve their community. Community members develop a community plan that outlines projects they will undertake to make their town a better place to live.

How was this Plan developed?

Preparation to develop this community plan commenced in April 2017. The Maude - She Oaks - Steiglitz community were asked for ideas and projects via a survey distributed to each resident. A public forum was held on the 16th of June at which those present voted to establish the top priorities for the Plan. From this process the following Projects were established as the priorities for the Maude - She Oaks - Steiglitz Community Plan 2017 – 2020.



2017-2020 Community Plan Key Projects

Improve Road Safety

Advocate for improved road safety, including such things as:

- Safer road shoulders
- Lowered speed limits, where appropriate
- Control truck and heavy haulage traffic / usage
- Improved road safety signage ٠
- Effectively manage roadside vegetation on bridge approaches
- Installation of Turning Lanes where appropriate
- Installation of street lighting at the intersection of Russells Bridge and Steiglitz ٠ roads

Maude Recreation Facilities

Active involvement in Maude Recreation Reserve improvements, to include such things as:

- Additional barbecue, rotunda & hotplate •
- Outdoor tables & seats
- Shade cloth over the playground •
- New community hall & safe parking •
- Tennis court refurbishment
- More playground equipment •
- Landscaping & plantings
- Interpretive Historical Signage •
- Ensure facilities are accessible for all
- Make sure there is strong community consultation for •
- new developments
- Cricket nets
- Coffee van
- Food vans
- Produce stall
